<p>MATHS Children will: Counting, Partitioning and Calculating – Use knowledge of place value and x facts up to 10x10 to derive division facts involving decimals. Solve multi step problems involving fractions, decimals and %. Choose the correct calculation at each stage Securing Number Facts and Understanding Shape- represent and interpret sequences, simple algebra, order a set of fractions, square numbers, convert between units of measure, find equivalent fractions, decimals and %, make and draw shapes with accuracy and understand their properties. Handling Data and Measures –convert units of measure, construct and interpret frequency tables, bar charts, line graphs and pie charts, understand the terms MODE, MEAN, MEDIAN and RANGE, read and interpret scales, probability.
