Headteacher Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the summer term. It is a term packed with a wide range of activities and events, and I am looking forward to some sunshine with increased outdoor learning. I am pleased to inform you that Park View Academy is nearly at full capacity, with many year groups full. We have had 25 new children join the school this year, and it is great to see them settling in and making new friendships across the school. However, we have some places in our Nursery and Reception classes. If you or your friends need a school place for a child, please ask them to speak with Mrs Fityo in the main office.

Our term started with book launches this week alongside the library and revamped reading areas. Year 6 has begun reading Mrs Perryman's favourite book, *Once*, and Reception has been using *Gecko's Eggs* as the stimulus for all their work in the provision around EYFS.

Finally, before half-term, our sponsored reading events raised a whopping £1,240, with Usborne adding 60% to that amount. The school's Reading Ambassadors have been responsible for selecting books for all year groups and budgeting the order themselves. Thank you all for your support.

On the horizon, many of our statutory assessments are coming up in Years 6, 4 and 1. It has been great to see the children return to school in such a confident and assured manner, and they are progressing very well.
