Dear parents and carers,

Finally, some summer sun has arrived. Our enrichment clubs started this week with a wide variety of clubs and curriculum-linked activities from Drama to Computing club, and from Reading to TT Rockstars. We have had over 200 children in clubs this week which is amazing!

Our additional tutoring sessions have also continued with children in Years 6, 5, 3, 2 and 1 getting bespoke support from staff in school. Attendance in these sessions has been extremely high.

Thank you to those staff who give up their time to support the children with their learning. Next week, Year 6 children start their assessments.
